Manifest Jesus was the Lamb of God and the Son of God.

Q18.1 What is His hour?

- His suffering, crucifixion, death and resurrection.

To teach.

Q18.3 What does this mean when Jesus says “Father, glorify Thy name”?

Honor the Father’s redemptive mission to be accomplished thru Jesus Christ.

Father has been glorified thru the Son and His work to date. Father will be glorified in the future thru the resurrection of His Son, completing the Father's Redemptive Plan.

Signifies his death, vs. 33.

It is the unbelief who Jesus is.

Believe in Jesus, His Mission and receive Spiritual Life.

Will.

cause people's heart to be
hardened?

God did not literally or directly
cause the people heart to be
hardened.

Q18.11 Is there any hope
for the people?

Yes if they are converted, God
will heal them.

Q18.12 Did some of the Jewish rulers believe in Him?

Yes.

enough for salvation?

No.

Q18.14 How does John summarize these rulers who believed but did not confess Him?

Loved the approval of man rather than the approval of God.

Q18.15 Who did Jesus
cry out to?

Unknown.

Q18.16 When do
these events occur?

Unknown.

Q18.17 In vs. 44, what does it mean “*He who believes in Me does not believe in Me,*”?

Not|but Hebrew idiom emphasis that the Father sent him.

Q18.18 In vs. 47, is Jesus saying He will not judge a person for not following the words of Jesus Christ?

No.
