Frequently copied and translated

14 And Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit, and news about Him spread through all the surrounding district. 15 And He began teaching in their synagogues and was praised by all. 16 And He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up; and as was His custom, He entered the synagogue on the Sabbath, and stood up to read. 17 And the book of the prophet Isaiah was handed to Him. And He opened the book and found the place where it was written,

18 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because He anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor. He has sent Me to proclaim release to the captives, and recovery of sight to the blind, to set free those who are oppressed, 19 to proclaim the favorable year of the Lord.

20 And He closed the book, gave it back to the attendant and sat down; and the eyes of all in the synagogue were fixed on Him. 21 And He began to say to them, "Today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing."

Isaiah was a prophet (Luke 4:21; Deuteronomy 18:20)

Isaiah wrote his prophecies 740 years prior to Jesus (Isaiah 6:1)

Jesus read from an old scroll that had been copied for over 700+ years

Jesus read from an old scroll that had been translated from Hebrew to Greek 200 years B.C.

Jesus called this reading scripture

18 Now it shall come about when he sits on the throne of his kingdom, he shall write for himself a copy of this law on a scroll in the presence of the Levitical priests. 19 It shall be with him and he shall read it all the days of his life, that he may learn to fear the Lord his God, by carefully observing all the words of this law and these statutes, 20 that his heart may not be lifted up above his countrymen and that he may not turn aside from the commandment, to the right or the left, so that he and his sons may continue long in his kingdom in the midst of Israel. **The king was to treasure his copy
He was to read his copy always**

His copy was called "law" and "statutes"
From his copy the king would learn to fear God

Daniel's 1st prophecy of Media-Persia 605 BC

Media-Persia ascended to prominence 539 BC

- **605-539 = 66 years prior to fulfillment**

Daniel's 1st prophecy of Greece 605 BC

Greece ascended to prominence 330 BC

- **605-330 = 275 years prior to fulfillment**

Daniel's prophecy of Alexander the Great 547 BC

Alexander the Great rose to power 330 BC

- **547-330 = 217 years prior to fulfillment**

Daniel's 1st prophecy of Rome 605 BC

Rome ascended to prominence 27 BC

- **605-27 = 578 years prior to fulfillment**

Over a period of 70 years, Daniel foretold the rise and fall of numerous nations and their leaders.

From 66 years before their occurrence to 578 years before, Daniel knew what was going to happen and when it was going to happen.

How did he know these things?

Claiming a Divine origin
