- It's not the music, but the volume.

# Clear Bible Examples

Jn 6:27 "not work for the food which perishes, but for the food with endures..."

1Sam 8:7 "not rejected you, but they have rejected Me" (rejected Samuel vv 1...5)

Acts 5:4 "not lied to men but to God" (lied to Peter, v2...8 & to Holy Spirit! v3)

#### Miss it ... error!

Jam 5:12 "*not* swear ... *but* let your yes be yes" Heb 6:13,17; 2Co 1:23; Gal 1:20

1Pt 3:3,4 "not external—braid hair, jewelry, put on apparel; but the hidden person"
