Easter HUMAN traditions

- Special emphasis Most important 1st day of week in the year
- Ash Wednesday Ashes on head to sig. penitence; FlowerC
- Lent Forty days of "fasting" to imitate Christ' fasting
- Palm Sunday Beg. "Holy Week." Processional; palm branches
- Good Friday "Service of Shadows"

Origin? — *NOT the NT*! Cmpr Mk 7:5,7,8,9,13 ...

Sounds good!

Rom 14:5?

- Setting time of transition (Jews)
 NOT NEW human inventions for worship
- Context God accepted individual liberties v3
 <u>NOT</u> unauthorized inventions of worship
- Harmony Mk 7:1-9

OK to establish special day of "washing" hands, cups ... to symbolize "washing" of bap. into C.?
