Christian? Soldier? Policeman? Carry Weapons?

Ex 20:13 "Thou shalt not kill" KJV

Ex 20:13 "You shall not murder" NASB, NKJV, ESV

Gen 9:6 "By man his blood shall be shed"

"murder" - "1. The <u>unlawful</u> killing of one human being by another, especially with premeditated malice." AHD [und. mine]

"capital punishment" - "the <u>legally authorized</u> killing of someone as punishment for a crime" OxfordDict [und. mine]

Why? Gen 9:6 "For in the image of God He made man."

"kill" ≠ "kill"... murder!

Unintentional vs Intentional killing Num 35:9f

v11 cities of refuge if "kills a person unintentionally" NASB "accidentally" NKJV; "without intent" ESV

vv22-23 "... without enmity... without lying in wait... not his enemy nor seeking his injury

v16f...18 "But if ... he is a murderer; the murderer shall surely be put to death"

v19...27 "The blood avenger himself shall <u>put</u> the murderer <u>to death</u>" ... "the blood avenger <u>kills</u> the manslayer, he will not be guilty of blood"

"kill" ≠ "kill"... murder!

Self defense vs UNjustified killing

Ex 22:2-3 "If the thief is caught while breaking in and is struck so that he dies, there will be no bloodguiltiness on his account. But if the sun has risen on him, there will be bloodguiltiness on his account. (Jer 2:34)

Jn 10:10 "the thief comes only to steal, to kill, and destroy"

"kill" ≠ "kill"... murder!

Observe

- The "blood avenger" was not guilty of murder.
- Those "who" exercised legitimate capital punishment were not guilty of murder.
- The man who killed accidentally was not guilty of murder.
- Self defense from a thief not guilty of murder.

"kill" # "kill"... murder!

Mt 5:38-42? "Do not resist..."turn to him the other [cheek] also"

"Eye for an eye..."? Ex 21:22-25 (22:9; 23:1-9); Lev 24:10-23; Dt 19:15-21 - Measure of civil punishment to be meted out, NOT personal vengence.

Mt 5:43-48!



<u>Attitude</u> behind murder = guilty!

Mt 5:21-22 ""You have heard that the ancients were told, 'YOU SHALL NOT COMMIT MURDER' ...
22 "But I say to you that everyone who is angry with his brother shall be guilty before the court; and whoever says to his brother, 'You good-for-nothing,' shall be guilty before the supreme court; and whoever says, 'You fool,' shall be guilty enough to go into the fiery hell. (contemptuous anger)

1Jn 3:15 "Everyone who <u>hates</u> his brother is a murderer; and you know that <u>no murderer has</u> <u>eternal life abiding in him</u>.

Attitude behind killing ...

1Ki 2:5 "shed the blood of war in peace"

```
Contemptuous anger, hatred (Mt 5:21f; 1Jn 3:15), "grudge" (Gen 27:41; Mk 6:19), envy (Mt 27:18), jealousy (Gen 37:11...20); etc. can lead to actual murder. Beware! Jam 1:14-15
```

1Sam 16:7 "the Lord looks at the heart"!

Rom 13:1-4 "he is God's servant ..." ESV - in carrying out the purpose of "governing authorities" (civil authority)

Police officers, constables, sheriff, etc.

"... does not bear the sword [pistol] for nothing [in vain ESV]"

Can be abused? Yes, and has been for centuries. Religious leaders? Parental authority? Financial stewards? etc. *Does not negate the right and need of their existence!*

Ac 10:1-2 "Cornelius, a centurion of what was called the Italian cohort" ["regiment" NKJV]

Military leaders, soldiers, etc.

Lk 3:14 "What shall we do?"

Can be oppressive, cruel? Yes, and has been for centuries. Does not negate the right and need of their existence!

"What about....?" Joe? Mary? Me?

Personal responsibility to examine self -

Lam 3:40; Hag 1:5; Lk 16:29; 1Co 11:28;

2Co 13:5; Jam 1:22-24; etc.

Personal judgment by the Lord - 2Co 5:10; Rom 14:12

Even murderers can be *forgiven!*Ac 9:1...22:16: Ac 2:23...38
