Scriptures ... ⇒ "destruction"!

#### Mt 16:6-12

- **v6** "beware of the leaven of the P. and S."
- v11 "How is it that you do not understand...?"
- v12 "Then they understood that He did <u>not</u> say to beware of the <u>leaven</u> of bread, <u>but</u> of the <u>teaching</u> of the P. and S."

"Metonymy" - "a figure of speech in which the name of one thing is used in place of that of another associated with or suggested by it (Ex.: the White House for the President)" Webster's New World Dict.

Exam. - **pen** [written word] mightier than **sword** [war, force]

#### Clear Bible Examples

Lk 16:29 "Moses" - for his writings (cause for effect)

Gen 25:23 "nations" - for E. & J. (effect for cause)

1Jn 4:1 "spirits" - for prophets (cause for effect)

# Critical! Misinterpret/ ignorance...false doctrine... alleged contradictions...rejection of Christ

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Jn 6:32-33 "bread of God...comes down out of heaven...life"
    v34 - misunderstood -> mistaken expectations! (cmpr soc. Gos. today)
Jn 6:54 "He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood ..."
    V52,60,66 - misunderstood & rejected Him! (Today - transubstantiation)
"Metonymy" - "a figure of speech in which the name of one thing is

"bread out of heaven" - provided physical life v31 (Moses)
"bread out of heaven" - provides eternal life - GOSPEL of C. vv63,68
  "flesh" & "blood" further define the "bread" one must "eat" - the gospel
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"eat...drink" - physical act necessary to physical life v26
"eat...drink" - BELIEVE - mental act - nec. to "eternal life" v47,48

of the *crucified* Messiah! v51

"Anointing" = chrisma, an ointment made usu. of oil and herbs. Clearly figurative. Metonymy - one thing put for another

     "word of Christ" given by the Spirit Col 3:16
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#### **Acts 1:5**

"baptized in the Holy Spirit" (HS himself inside of you / tongues) "power" given by the HS to the apostles ⇒ "witnesses" v8; Lk 24:48-49

"Emergence of the Church of Christ Denomination" by David Harrel (orig. 1962)

#### **Characteristics of NT Christians**

- Believe had "the truth" Gal 2:4-5; Jude 3
  - Will. to debate Ac 6:9; 15:2; 17:17; 18:28
  - Know. of truth emp. 22 ltrs; 1Ti 3:14;
     6:6,11,15,16; 5:7,21; 6:2; 2Tim 2:15-16
- Bel. in "the church" 1Jn 5:19; Eph 4:4-6
- Strict morally 1Pt 4:3-4
- Fervent Ac 2:42,44-46; 5:42; 8:4; 15:35
   (to sociologist = "sect")

"Using the terminology of modern religious sociologists and historians, the early nineteeth century religious movement led by Alexander Campbell & Barton Stone was a "legalistic sect" (Harrell, p9)

Note: Do not let such terms disturb you! Sadd. (Ac 5:17), Phar. (Ac 15:5) ... But also of the early church! Ac 24:5,14; 28:22

# Characteristics of "Denomination" (to sociologist)

- Less dogmatic
- Tolerant of other churches
- Generally accept moral standards of society
- Less active, fervent more interested in world about them

# Changes in the churches of Christ "sect" ... ⇒... "denomination" (H. p21-23)

- 1. Property Less to Property Owning
- 2. Economic Poverty to Economic Wealth
- 3. From Cultural Periphery to Cultural Center
- 4. From Refusing Unworthy Members to Receiving Them
- 5. From Unspecialized Ministers to Specialized
- 6. From Emphasis on Evangelism to Emphasis on Education

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
